Big and *enormous* are adjectives. We say a horse is *big*, but an elephant is **enormous**. *Enormous* means *very big*. It's an extreme adjective.

scary → terrifying

bad → horrible

very big = enormous

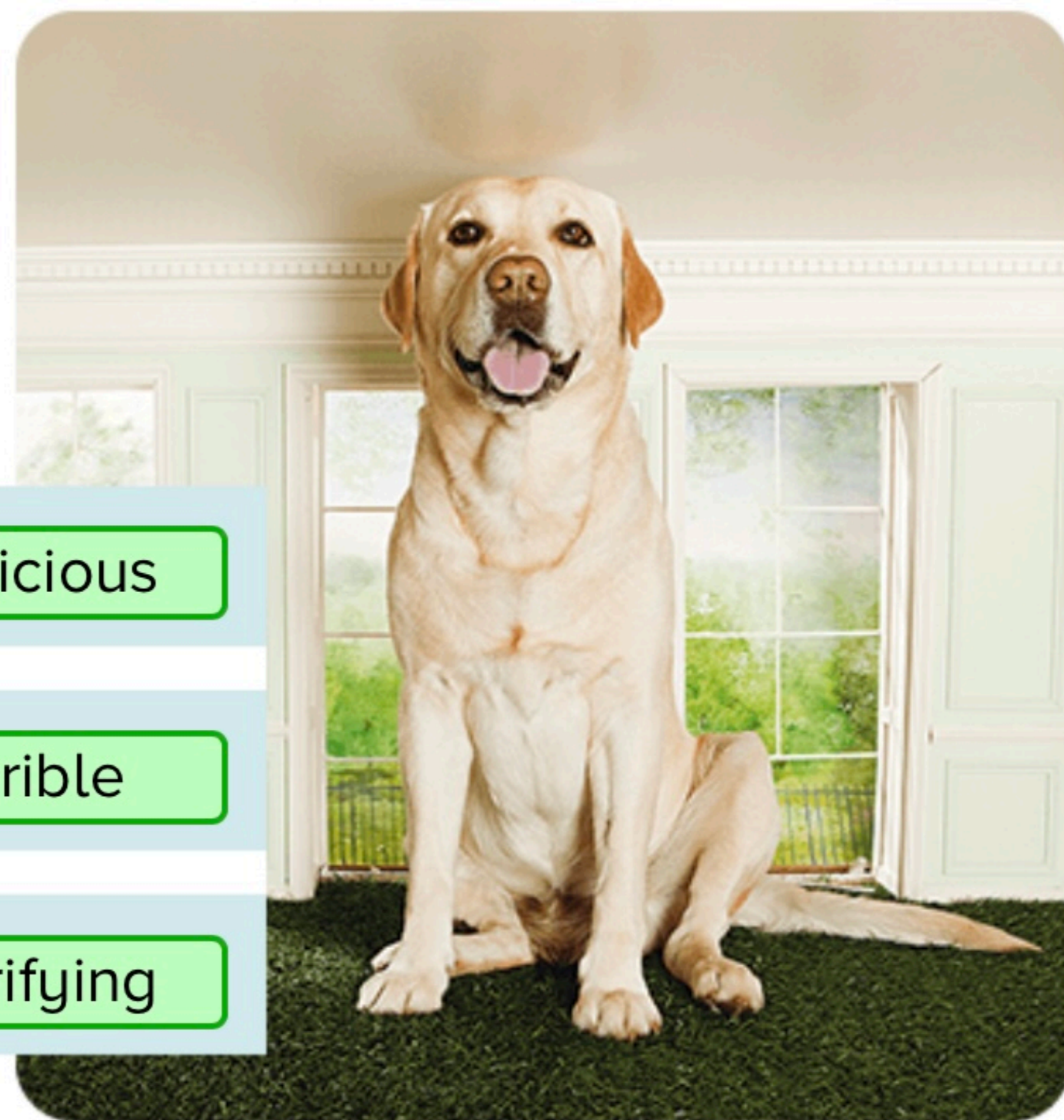
