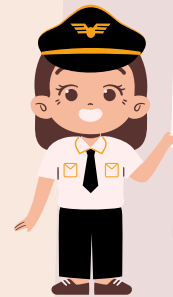

- **Do you** wear uniform?

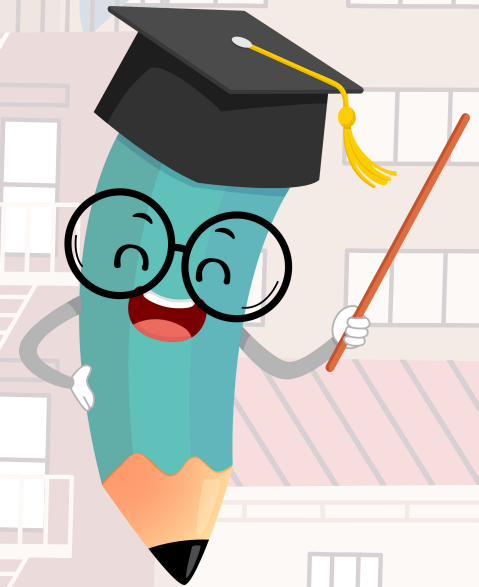
Yes, I do. I wear a T-shirt and trousers. / No, I don't.

- Do you work during the day or at night?

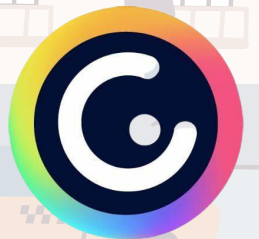
I work during the day.
